- 1) Consider submitting written testimony to Council Member Jim Graham regarding the Mayor's budget proposal to allow beer, wine, and liquor stores to remain open until midnight (currently 10 p.m.); increase the sales tax on off premises alcohol sales from 9% to 10%; allow bars to sell alcohol beginning at 8 a.m. on Sundays (currently 10 a.m.); and allow liquor stores to sell alcohol on Sundays. These proposed changes are estimated to raise \$6.3 million for the city's general fund in FY12—the revenue from the latter two proposals would be used to fund the MPD reimbursable detail program under ABRA.
