ANC 6A & ANC 6C Transportation and Public Space Committees

will hold a joint meeting to review the District Department of Transportation's

K St. NE Corridor Safety Assessment

Concerns raised by ANCs 6A and 6C over safety along the K St. NE corridor, including high traffic speeds and pedestrian and cyclist safety issues, have prompted the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) to perform a corridor safety assessment along K St. NE from North Capitol St. to Florida Ave. Following traffic data collection and analysis, DDOT has prepared three concept design alternatives, which were presented to ANCs 6A and 6C in May 2017. This joint public meeting is being held to further engage the community and solicit feedback on the design concepts.

Some proposed improvements and alterations include:

- Updated signage and improved signage visibility
- Curb extensions to decrease crossing distance
- Removal of rush hour parking restrictions (allowing 24-hour parking) on K St.
- Road diet with addition of left-turn lanes
- Changes to traffic pattern at the 8th St./K St./West Virginia Ave. intersection

A representative from DDOT will present the study findings and recommendations. Input from the community will be solicited regarding overall concepts and specific details within the proposed designs. **All members of the public are encouraged to attend.**
