Re: Substantial Change in Khans BBQ License

Dear Mr. Chairman:

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on July 14, 2011, with a quorum present, our eight member Commission voted (6-0-1) to protest this matter.

On July 15, 2011, ABRA placarded a substantial change for an entertainment endorsement for Khans BBQ, LLC located at 1125 H Street NE (#ABRA-84082). Accordingly, the ANC protests this substantial change based on (1) adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood; (2) adverse impact on the residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety in the neighborhood; (3) adverse impact on real property values; and (4) over-concentration of ABC establishments.

The Board should understand that, as is his consistent practice, Commissioner Alberti was not:

- 2/. present during the vote;
- 3/. nor was he copied on any email exchanges or correspondence related to this case.
