At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting on September 10, 2015,¹ our Commission voted 7-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to write you in support of the Applicant's request for \$1.6 million in funding from DHCD and private sources to pay for planned renovations to the 10-unit building at 1431 E Street, N.E., owned by the Applicant (the E Street Cooperative). The Commission understands that the funding is needed to make necessary repairs to the existing structure, including installing new windows and a new roof, updating the common areas of the building, and furnishing new electrical and heating systems. The Applicant has indicated that a letter of support from the Commission is a necessary component of its request for the funding.
