At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting on November 9, 2017,¹ our Commission voted 8-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to support the design of the proposed rear addition at 1015 D Street, NE. The design has taken measures to ensure that it will not disrupt the historic character of the neighborhood. Our support is conditional on the development not making any changes that negatively impact the traffic flow in the alley behind the house, and that signs be posted notifying neighbors when the alley will be closed for construction.
