At our regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting on April 10, 2008, our Commission voted unanimously to request DCRA provide the ANC a 60 day extension to allow the ANC sufficient time to study the laws applicable to the proposed street closing and gather greater community input with regards to this specific closure request and proposed development.
