Re: Removal of Female Ginkgo Tree on 200 block of 12<sup>th</sup> Place, NE

Dear Mr. Caldwell,

On February 10, 2005, at a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting, ANC 6A voted unanimously to support the petition by residents of the 200 block of 12<sup>th</sup> Place, NE to remove a female gingko tree and replant with another type of tree.

The specimen in question (ID: CA-0907-086) has been catalogued in fair to poor condition by the Casey Trees Endowment's street tree inventory based on wounds/cavity of 34% to 66% circumference and decay in wounds/cavity.

Based on the Female Ginkgo Tree Removal Policy, it is our understanding that Urban Forestry Administration will schedule the removals based on staffing levels and contract funding availability, usually within six months. Please confirm the scheduled removal date with us in writing so that we may inform the residents of the affected block.
