At our regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting on February 14, 2008, our Commission voted 5-0 (with five commissioners required for a quorum) to support the above referenced application.

The applicant, Mr. Louis Fiore, presented plans to our Commission for the excavation and construction of a rear addition onto his primary residence. Mr. Fiore testified that the addition will be "sunken" so as to limit its visibility from the rear of the property.
