Re: Police Interaction with the Public during the Covid-19 Epidemic

Dear Commander Kane,

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting<sup>1</sup> on October 8, 2020, our Commission voted 6-0-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to express our concerns regarding testimony received during the ANC 6A Community Listening Session of August 24, 2020. At that meeting, community member Mr. Rico Dancy, who self identified as being deaf/hard of hearing, said that MPD officers that responded to him on a call were not inclined to contact an interpreter for him.

In addition, Mr. Dancy and others have said officers have not been wearing face masks when interacting with the public. The ANC requests that all MPD officers remain in compliance with present health and safety guidelines and regulations pertaining to ensuring reasonable accommodations for all community members, including sign language interpretation.
