At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting¹ on November 14, 2019, our Commission voted 7-0-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to support the construction of a two-story rear addition, a new two-story garage, and a new basement entrance at the residence at 1355 A Street NE, in the Capitol Hill Historic District. The design has taken measures to ensure that the addition is not visible from the street, and it will not disrupt the historic character of the neighborhood. Our support is conditional on the design not including a pedestrian door at the alley side of the garage.
