At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting<sup>1</sup> on October 10, 2019, our Commission voted 6-0-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to support the construction of two new two-story garages in the Capitol Hill Historic District at 1363 and 1365 A Street, NE. The design has taken measures to ensure that the addition is not visible from the street, and it will not disrupt the historic character of the neighborhood. Our support is conditional on the rear windows being horizontal casement windows placed at a height of at least 5 feet 8 inches above the interior second story floor.
