At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed meeting¹ on January 13th, 2022, our Commission voted 8-0-0 (with 5 Commissioners required for a quorum) to support the design of the proposed construction of an existing one-story garage to be rebuilt and expanded into a two-story carriage house, and the third-floor addition and roof deck at main house in the Capitol Hill Historic District at 308 11th Street, NE.

The design has taken measures to ensure that the addition is not visible from the street, and it will not disrupt the historic character of the neighborhood.
