Grant Application Consideration:

Hill Family Biking submitted an application for a grant of \$1,000 towards a public art installation project in front of Maury Elementary School (MES). The artwork, in collaboration with Maury and contracted with Chalk Riot, would be placed in the crosswalk at 13th and Tennessee Avenue, NE. After the art is completed, there would be a neighborhood block party to celebrate (August 30, 2024). Intend for ribbon cutting to be Labor Day weekend. It was suggested -and agreed to--that Chalk Riot consult with the MES art teacher, Ms. Bomba, for inspiration. The COC voted unanimously to support the grant request.
