Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Committee members present: Elizabeth Nelson (Chair), Rose Williams (no quorum)

Community member present: Carmen Jackson, Eliot-Hine Middle School Business Manager and member of PTSA

- I. Agenda
 1. Adopted.
 2. Most committee members were unable to attend due to proximity to Thanksgiving holiday but the decision was made not to cancel since the Eliot-Hine grant application was on the agenda.
 3. Discussion of possible committee involvement in Medical Marijuana issues was deferred because so many members were absent.
- II. Status of ANC/COC activities

Recommendation to accept bid from Capital Community News for Hill Rag and Community Guide advertising was approved by the commissioners at the November 10 meeting.
- III. Grant application from Eliot-Hine Middles School PTSA
 1. Ms. Jackson presented the grant application. She explained that Eliot-Hine was projected to have 297 students but instead received 400. It is good to have a larger student body but they were unprepared for such a large enrollment. When Eliot and Hine consolidated, Eliot had no library and the existing Hine library contents were transferred to the Eliot site. However there were very few volumes; most were out of date and/or in poor repair. Even so, these books have largely been parceled out to the under-resourced classrooms leaving only 200-or-so books in the library itself. There is a part-time librarian, Ms. Bradshaw, who is committed to doing as best she can. She has library sessions with students to whom she reads or offers computer instruction. The children are very interested in reading but, with so few titles, there are limited opportunities to borrow books.
 2. DCPS has no plans or resources to provide additional library materials. So, Ms. Bradshaw has been aggressively pursuing outside funding sources. While the Capitol Hill Community Foundation paid for new libraries in the local elementary schools some years ago, the middle schools were not included. However, the Capitol Hill Community Foundation recently gave the school \$700 which will cover the cost of two mobile carts and a few books. The Eliot Hine PTSA is requesting \$4,000 from ANC 6A to purchase additional books.
 3. The two committee members present agreed that there would be few more appropriate ways to spend ANC grant money than to provide library materials for a school that has next-to-none. Literacy is key to a successful adult life. The school is in-boundaries to most children in ANC 6A; a significant number of ANC 6A children currently attend. Furthermore, the principal, faculty and staff

10. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED PROJECT/ACTIVITY

Books and media for the library. Unlike most of the Capitol Hill elementary schools, who received new libraries courtesy the CHCF, Eliot-Hine's current selection of library books is small and outdated – nearly non-existent - and we need a range of reading levels to accommodate our readers at advanced levels as well as engaging below-basic students. Some of the selection addresses character-building and anti-bullying, and some books are for enjoyment. There are a few for adults, too, such as teaching math to special education students, fostering growth among our staff. Library books and media are not offered by DCPS.

Eliot-Hine is in-boundaries to ANC 6A. A significant number of students live in ANC 6A and we hope to attract more by improving our offerings and facilities – including the library. Our staff and students will greatly benefit from a renewed library inventory. Our focus is literacy, and having books that offer current information and new fiction to enjoy will encourage students to read. The importance of literacy to a successful adult life cannot be overstated. An investment in children's education will not only benefit them but the entire community in which they live, improving our economics, public safety and intangible quality of life issues. Also, having a high-functioning middle-school helps attract families who can contribute in other ways to a vibrant community.
