Dear Board Members,

ANC 6A has not changed its decision to appeal the administrative decision of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs' Zoning Administrator to issue a Certificate of Occupancy for a "restaurant" for Cluck-U-Chicken at 1123 H Street NE.

I am certifying in writing that the position our Commission took on September 8, 2005, to appeal the Cluck-U-Chicken certificate of occupancy issued by the Zoning Administrator has not been changed at any of the seven subsequent public Commission meetings held from September 8, 2005, to the last public Commission meeting held on April 13, 2006.

To be clear, while four Commissioners may not agree with the decision made on September 8, 2005, it takes five Commissioners to vote to rescind any previous action taken by a Commission. To date, our Commission had not rescinded the decision to appeal the certificate of occupancy of Cluck-U-Chicken made on September 8, 2005.

In close, any letter signed by four Commissioners does not negate the decision or great weight of an ANC made at a duly noticed, public meeting.
