**Re: Change a One-Way Traffic Pattern to a Two-Way Traffic Pattern
Notice 07-56-TS**

Dear Mr. Fengler:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, Constitution Avenue, N.E., from 3rd Street to North Carolina Avenue operates as one-way westbound between the hours of 7:00 AM to 9:30 AM, Monday-Friday. It is proposed based on the recommendations of the Capitol Hill Transportation Study, that the above section of Constitution Avenue be changed to a two-way traffic pattern at all times.

Therefore, the Traffic Services Administration will change Constitution Avenue N.E., between 3rd Street and North Carolina Avenue from a one-way westbound traffic pattern during the hours of 7:00 AM to 9:30 AM to a two-way traffic pattern at all times.

The following traffic control devices will be installed or removed during the change in traffic pattern along Constitution Avenue, N.E.:

- Removal of reversible lane signing
- Removal of Do Not Enter signing during specified hours
- Removal of One-way signing during specified hours
- Signal Timing and lane assignment indicators

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Traffic Services Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., 7th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20009.
