Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs

Mr. Willoughby,

In our letter dated February 22, 2007, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6A (ANC 6A) requested that the Office of the Inspector General investigate potential fraud within the Department (DCRA). At that time we provided information to support our suspicions that fraudulent building permits had been issued for a property at 1405 N. Carolina Ave. NE. ANC 6A remains concerned about fraud within the DCRA. Since the property at 1405 N. Carolina Ave NE is in my Single Member District I have a particular interest in learning the status of your investigation of DCRA's conduct.

Since six months have past since we submitted our request, we are eager to learn what your office has discovered. Therefore, I am submitting a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request¹ for information on the status and findings of any/all investigations into the conduct of DCRA and its staff relating to the issuance of building permits. This includes a request for all documents, reports, written communication, emails, etc. relating to any/all investigations initiated within the last two years on this subject.
