RE: ANC 6A opposes public space permit for 1400 Maryland Ave NE.

Dear Ms. Felder.

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on October 9, 2008, our Commission voted unanimously to oppose 1400 MD Ave Ltd Empire Leasing Inc's application for a public space permit for 1400 Maryland Ave NE.

Our Commission believes that the Public Space Committee should deny this application because:

- 1. The request is unprecedented in its size and scope;
- 2. The public harm resulting from the use of public space for a gas station greatly outweighs the public benefit;
- 3. Granting this public space request will set a dangerous precedent that private landowners are able to use extensive parcels public space solely because it aids their business:
- 4. Granting this public space application will violate the 2007 comprehensive plan;
- 5. The application violates Public Space Regulations and DDOT policies; and
- 6. The applicant has been cited for public space violations at the site and that the site's poor upkeep has lead to two condemnation proceedings against owner of the property.
