
 <u>Project</u> outreach team will provide project updates and address community safety concerns with related contractor work.



Impacts to ANC 6A

- B2 line shifts 3 to 5 blocks east as the new C41
- <u>90/92</u> becomes <u>C51</u> and <u>C53</u>
 - C51 diverts from Florida Ave NW at New Jersey Ave NW to H St, then resumes old route at 8th St NE.
- <u>X8</u> becomes <u>C43</u> 🙂
 - Will extend all the way to Navy Yard, but diverts from Union Station at Stanton Park
- <u>D4</u> and <u>D8</u> combine to become <u>D36</u> and <u>C71</u> \bigcirc
 - C71 will extend all the way to Fort Totten.
- <u>D6</u> becomes <u>D24</u> ①
 - Truncated at McPherson Square, but will extend east all the way to Deanwood via Benning Road Metro.
- Former rush hour only X3 line becomes <a>C57 and runs all day <a>C
 - 5am to midnight every 30 minutes from U St to Capitol Heights.
- X2 becomes D22
- X9 becomes D2X

Re: 17th Street NE/SE Corridor Safety Project & Protected Bike Lanes

Dear Chairperson Sauceda-Guzman, Chairperson Felder, Chairperson Ryder and Commissioners,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to provide a written Notice of Intent (NOI) on proposed traffic and parking modifications.

DDOT proposes to reconfigure 17th Street SE from Bladensburg Rd NE to Potomac Ave SE with corridor safety modifications and bicycle facilities as shown in the plans. The project is characterized by travel lane reductions (4 to 3 north of Benning, 2 to 1 south of Benning), the inclusion of pedestrian median refuges at Lyman St NE, Lang Pl NE and H St NE, reduced crossing distances at all crossings between Benning Rd NE and Potomac Ave SE a two-way protected bike lane (PBL) on the west side of the roadway between Bladensburg and I St NE, shifting to a one-way southbound PBL from I St to Potomac Ave SE, and a reduction of 28 parking spaces from the west side of the street over the course of this 1.7 mile long corridor. Facilities will tie into proposed changes on Mount Olivet Rd. NE (previously noticed as NOI 23-93-TESD)

Left turn prohibitions will be implemented for both northbound and southbound 17th at Potomac due to the obtuse angle of that turn and potential for intersection movement "overlaps" in space left turns for southbound will be diverted to E St SE, and left turns for northbound will be diverted to G St SE.

In service of the turn restrictions described above, DDOT proposes to reconfigure the 1600 block of G Street SE to allow westbound traffic on G Street will facilitate left turns off of northbound 17^{th} at a more typical intersection geometry.

A one-way roadway conversion will be implemented on F St NE and Eames Pl NE to facilitate the installation of a temporary sidewalk, and parking will be reconfigured to accommodate this change.

We are issuing this NOI at the current design stage to solicit public feedback through the ongoing development stages of this project.




Figure 1 The 2-way protected bike lane will run on the west side from Bladensburg Rd NE to 1 St NE




Figure 4: 17th St NE/SE from moveDC 2021 bicycle priority network map of area.

This project originated from the MoveDC plan, and these projects will form the basis of DC's all ages and abilities bicycling network. This is the second, third, and fourth phase of the 17th Street corridor in development, with planned delivery of phase two(Benning to Bladensburg), phase three (Potomac Ave SE to East Capitol), and phase four (East Capitol to Benning), proposed in that order.
