ANC6A08 in the month of June

At the June ANC6A08 Roundtable, community members discussed the Comstock Development (ZC #06-34) 1705-1729 East Capitol St SE) and traffic routing for the project as well as other concerns. Although 3 bedroom units have not been agreed to, Comstock has agreed to much of what 6A has asked.

Neighbors have reported that 1637 E St NE is being used as a group home. After checking with MPD to confirm this use, it was noted that their appears to be programming for this home occurring at Rosedale Recreation Center. A quick check with DCRA revealed that the location *did not* have the appropriate paperwork complete to fulfill the group home requirement. Let's all work together on this one.

This month, construction without permits and on Sundays has been noted on the 300 b/o 18th St NE and 200 b/o 19th St NE. On weekends call in illegal construction 311, notify Stephanie Nixon, and email dcra@dc.gov.

PROHIBITED

- Firecrackers of any kind!
- Any firework that explodes (e.g., Roman candles, bottle rockets, etc.)
- Sparklers more than 20 inches in length
- Side fuse/fuse at any length
